Citizenship Badge Content Creation Project

The Boys' Brigade Victoria



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Purpose

Boys' Brigade Victoria creating citizenship material has a number of purposes that will benefit multiple aspects of brigade and its members.

Assisting Boys through their Queen's Badge

Levels 1 and 2 of Citizenship are a requirement for the Queen's Badge. If a company does not include the citizenship requirements in their weekly program, this could be a barrier to boys attaining their Queen's Badge.

Resource to Companies

Many components of the citizenship badge require many hours of research and/or expertise to present well and it is the view of this document that spending hours in researching a topic, such as the Victorian Legal System, is not a primary or efficient function of officers in a company. These videos, presented by trained experts, can be used by officers in their preparations for citizenship presentations, should a company decide to include the citizenship program into their company nights.

Engaging with Partners / Community

The creation of these videos will involve working with many people connected to BB as well as experts in society, hopefully improving our relationships and promoting BB.

Resource to New Companies

These resources would be helpful to new companies who do not have the expertise or the manpower to run the citizenship program and ensures their boys do not have to miss out.

Overview

Since only the first two levels of Citizenship are required for a boy to attain their Queen's badge, developing material for these will be the priority. However, this document recognises the benefit of completing all four levels of the Citizenship program.

The material for each level will consist of 12 x 20 minute videos, 4 from each of the three areas of Relationship, Being Human, and Practical Living.

Boys from companies who do not facilitate the attainment of the citizenship badge will be able to access these videos online and then submit notes to the BBV Queen's Badge Coordinator to be approved.

Companies do not have to comply with the material or assessment method to continue awarding the Queen's Badge.

Oversight

This project will be overseen and then managed by the Boys' Brigade Victoria Queen's Badge Coordinator under the supervision of the Boys' Brigade Victoria State Executive.

The Queen's Badge Coordinator will work with other members of the executive throughout the project such as the Web Administrator, to assist with online access to the content created

Topics & Content Creators

The content creators are the person with relevant experience and or qualification who have agreed to produce content.

The topics will be the choice of each content creator within the parametres of page 28 of the Boys' Brigade Senior's Handbook.

Filming

Equipment

Location

The main film location will be Werribee Baptist Church. However, there is the option of other locations if particular content creators are unable to attend the above location.

Timeline

Due to the large amount of filming required we will be recording Level 1 content and producing it ready for Term 1, 2022 and Level 2 content for Term 1, 2023.



This timeline can then be replicated for level 2 videos being produced in January 2023.

Legal

Most logos used in the videos will either be in the possession of Boys' Brigade Australia/Victoria or in the public domain.

Any logos or images used in the videos that are not owned by The Boys' Brigade or that are in the public domain will be appropriately cited and referenced.

All content creators will be required to sign a contract which is in appendix C. Essentially this contract gives Boys' Brigade Victoria the exclusive rights to use and distribute the footage we take in any way.

Access & Promotion

The Level One Citizenship material will be available for Term One 2022 on 14th VIC Werribee's hub¹⁴. This will be through a link on the current Queen's Badge page (buit.ly/QueensBadge) or through: Awards > Citizenship > Level One Resources.

However, it is preferred that in the future these videos and future content move onto a state-based resource hub or website to increase accessibility.

Promotion for these resources will be through the QB Quarterly Newsletter and

Assessment Role

The role of assessment for any companies using these resources in their citizenship sessions remains with the companies. These companies will not be required to ascribe to the State based assessment system.

However, if a boys is not able to attain the award at his own company, then he may participate in the state-based system, allowing him to be eligible to receive his Queen's Badge. In this case he will be assessed by the Boys' Briagde Victoria Queen's Badge Coordinator.

Assessment Criteria

For each video a boy watches he will be required to submit half an A4 page of notes that demonstrate he has watched the video and submit them to the BBV QB Coordinator. They can be submitted at qbcoordinator@bbvic.com.au or through the online based task system, Click Up, aiming for introduction at the beginning of 2022.

RESOURCES

- If your company does not cover the citizenship award, these videos and the assessments method below can assist in getting your citizenship badge.
- This is particularly important as Citizenship levels 1&2 are a Queen's Badge requirement.

ASSESSMENT

If your company is running sessions to fit the Citizenship program then you can be assessed in your company and there is no need for any State assessment.

However, if you wish to be assessed by the State to gain your Citizenship badge then you will need to submit half an A4 page of notes per video that demonstrate you have learnt from the video. These need to be submitted to the BBV Queen's Badge Coordinator at qbcorrdinator@bbvic.com.au

Legal Contract

Content Licensing Agreement

- The Boys' Brigade Victoria

1. I certify that I am the creator of any content that I provide to The Boys' Brigade Victoria or film for The Boys' Brigade Victoria and/or that I am the owner of the complete work. If I am not the creator of some components of the content or they are not owned by me, then I declare that I have secured rights to the components with ability to relicense them.
2. I grant The Boys' Brigade Victoria a perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free and sole license to use any content that I will create or film within a five (5) year period commencing the year two thousand and twenty-one (2021) or have created within the last two (2) years concluding the year two thousand and twenty-one (2021) for the purposes of The Boys' Brigade Victoria or any related events.
3. I waive my moral rights to any content falling within the scope of this agreement.
 - a. There moral rights include:
 - i. The right of attribution (to be named as the content's author or creator)
 - ii. The right of integrity (my work may not be altered without my consent)
 - iii. The right against false attribution of work
4. I understand that I will not be paid any royalties, commissions or any other form of reimbursement for my works (or their uses) licensed under this agreement.
5. I acknowledge that no rights are granted to me to inspect the final product or any intermediary stages of the use of my content.
6. The licence granted permits The Boys' Brigade Victoria to transfer the licence to any other entity with no allowance for restrictions to be placed on this transfer by me.
7. No restrictions may be placed by me on the use of the works under any circumstances.
 - a. Uses include but are not limited to the reproduction, adaption, modification, publishing, public performance, public distribution and display of works.
8. If I have a dispute on licences granted under this contract or its terms, I will inform The Boys' Brigade Victoria by written notice at least ninety (90) days before taking this dispute before a mediator, arbitrator, tribunal or court. Both parties to this agreement will make efforts to resolve the dispute before the ninety (90) days concludes.
9. This agreement may be terminated by either party to this agreement if written notice is provided twenty-eight (28) days before the termination is to take place.
 - a. If terminated, the rights granted to The Boys' Brigade Victoria by me for previous works will still be held by The Boys' Brigade Victoria. Only future works will no longer be covered under this agreement.
10. Any changes to this agreement may only be accepted if they are provided in writing and signed by both parties.
11. The validity of this agreement as a whole and of other clauses will not be affected by the potential invalidity of any clause unless that invalidity impacts another clause.
12. I declare that I have read and understood the entirety of this agreement and that I accept it as stated.
