At some point either before or after your interview, you will have a uniform inspection. To ensure that you do well in this, your uniform needs to be a peak condition and presentation, so you best know what is required of you. On top of that, they will also ask you some questions about it that you need to be able to answer. Apart from succeeding your interview, being able to have a respectable uniform helps other Boys look up to you and gives you a chance to be a role model. It also allows you to well represent BB whenever you are wearing it in public, it might even make some people curious.
